They used their answers for points of further discussion about the topics. The Indian River County Store Assessment and Youth Tobacco Use data was provided to the group prior to the		
	meeting. The group discussed policy solutions like local licensing that could be the		
	'binder' holding business owners accountable for all federal, state, and local laws.		
	They discussed several scenarios where a local license could be suspended or revoked		
	after a set number of violations occurred. This would not replace current		
	enforcement by State Alcohol, Beverage and Tobacco, but local dollars raised by		
	licensing fees would augment enforcement locally and support the administration of
